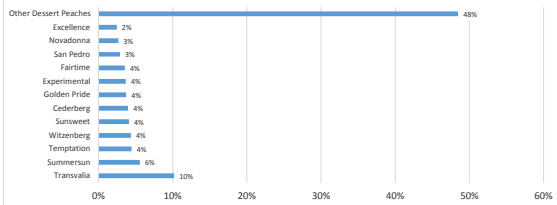

CONTRIBUTION TO TOTAL DESSERT PEACH AREA PER CULTIVAR

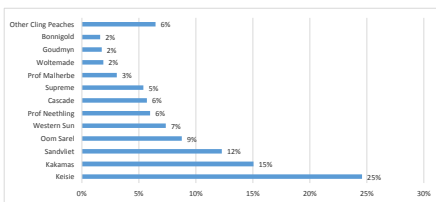

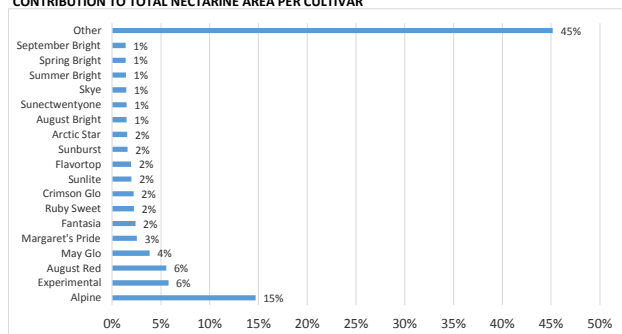

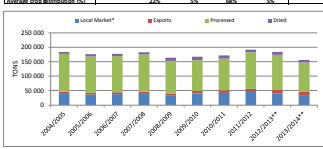

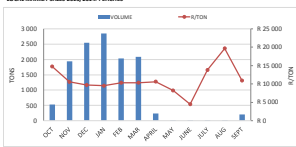

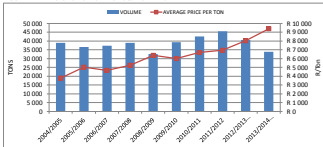
**LOCAL MARKET SALES 2013/2014: PEACHES**

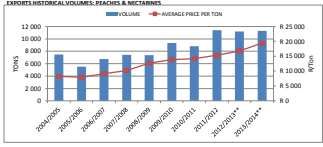

**LOCAL MARKET HISTORICAL SALES: PEACHES & NECTARINES**



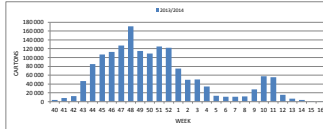

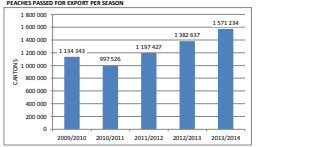

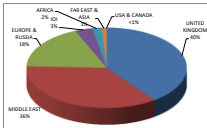
**PEACHES PASSED FOR EXPORT PER SEASON**

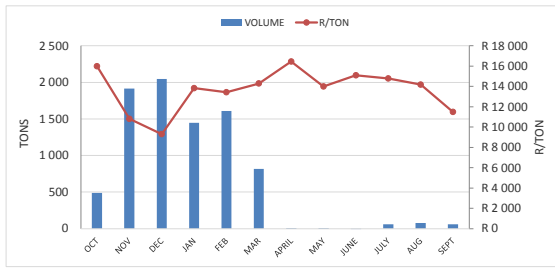

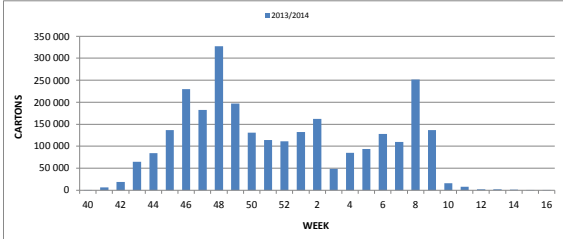

**NECTARINE LOCAL MARKET SALES 2013/2014**



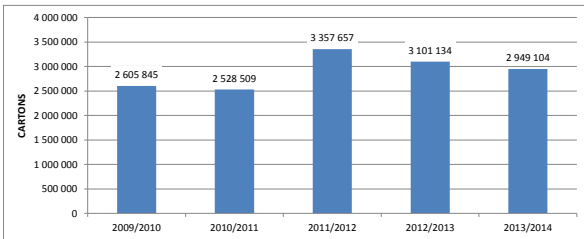

**PASSED FOR EXPORT PER WEEK: NECTARINES**



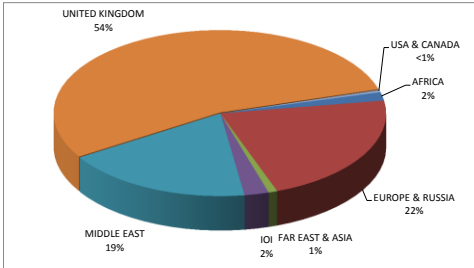
