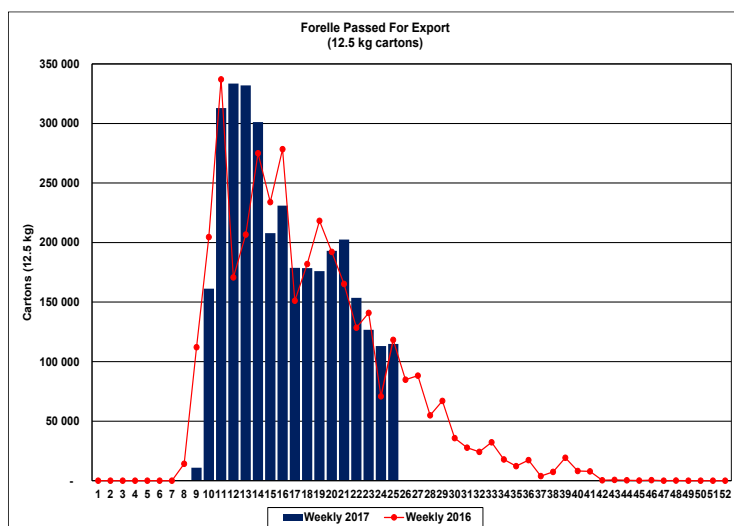
HIGHLIGHTS

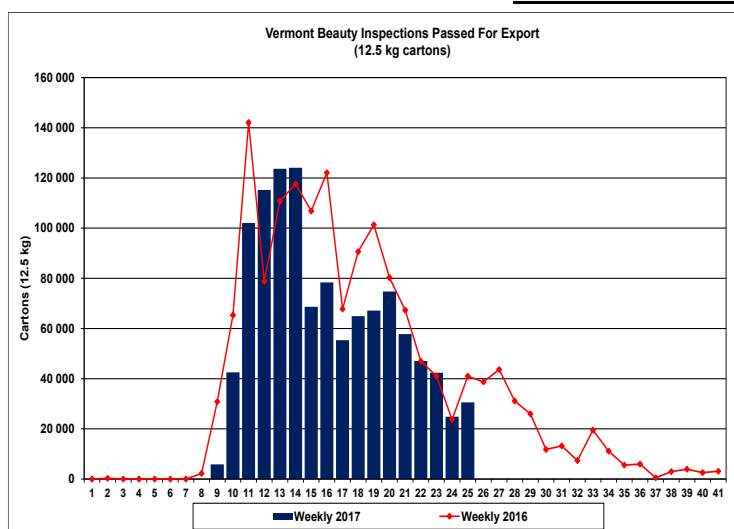
